- Manipulation of the flashlight or weapon mounted light (i.e. when the student turns the light on or off) is at the discretion of the instructor.
- ◆ Tactical or weapon mounted lights may be used during the qualification.
 - If using a weapon mounted light, light manipulation should be done with the support hand.
