**Position Summary:**

This position is responsible for performing duties that actively prevent or detect crime and enforce criminal statutes or ordinances of the State of Utah or any of its political subdivisions. Further responsibilities include responding to situations involving threats to public safety, making emergency decisions affecting the lives and health of others, and duties that consist of protecting and serving the community. Because of the above-listed duties, the employee's life or personal safety may be placed at risk.

**Essential Job Duties:**

The Police Officer is responsible for all general police functions. These functions include, but are not limited to, the following: patrolling the cities of Gunnison and Centerfield to interdict criminal activity, render aid, arrest or cite when appropriate, and protect and promote public peace. The Police Officer will be the initial investigator for allegations of criminal activity and will be responsible for the preliminary investigation of an incident. The Police Officer is generally the first responder at any public safety incident and as such should be well trained, competent, and professional in the performance of their duties. The Police Officer will be expected to provide a courteous, professional, and competent service to citizens and the communities of Gunnison and Centerfield. - Current Utah POST Certification, POST certified eligible, or ability to obtain a Waiver or Reactivation
- US Citizen, 21 years or older
- High School Diploma or GED
- Must pass a thorough background investigation which may include a financial investigation
- Must possess a valid Utah Driver's License
- Must pass a POST firearms qualification and demonstrate firearms proficiency
- Must complete 40 hours minimum of annual law enforcement training to maintain POST certification
- Must pass a pre-employment drug test and criminal background check
- Must pass a pre-employment physical fitness test (POST standard)
